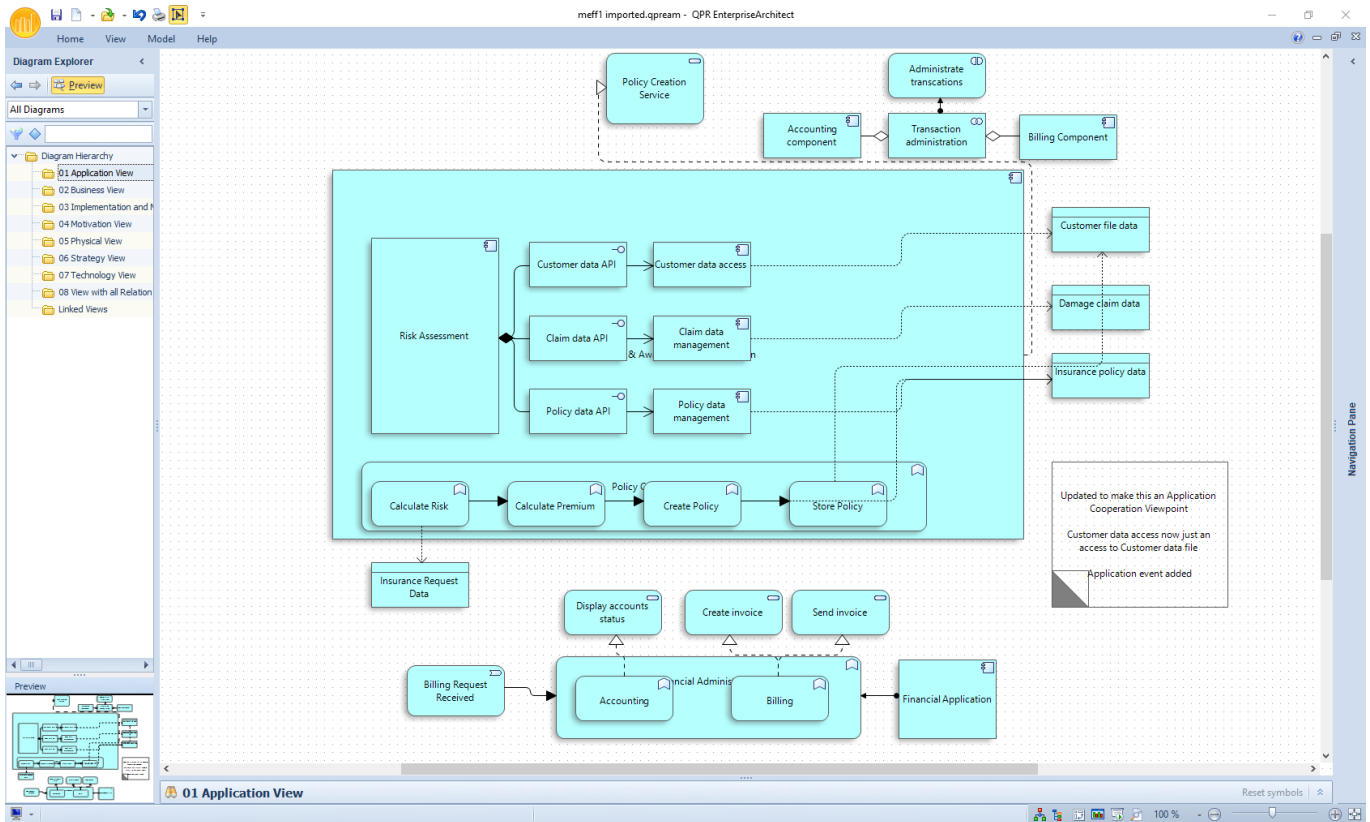

Views imported from Archi.

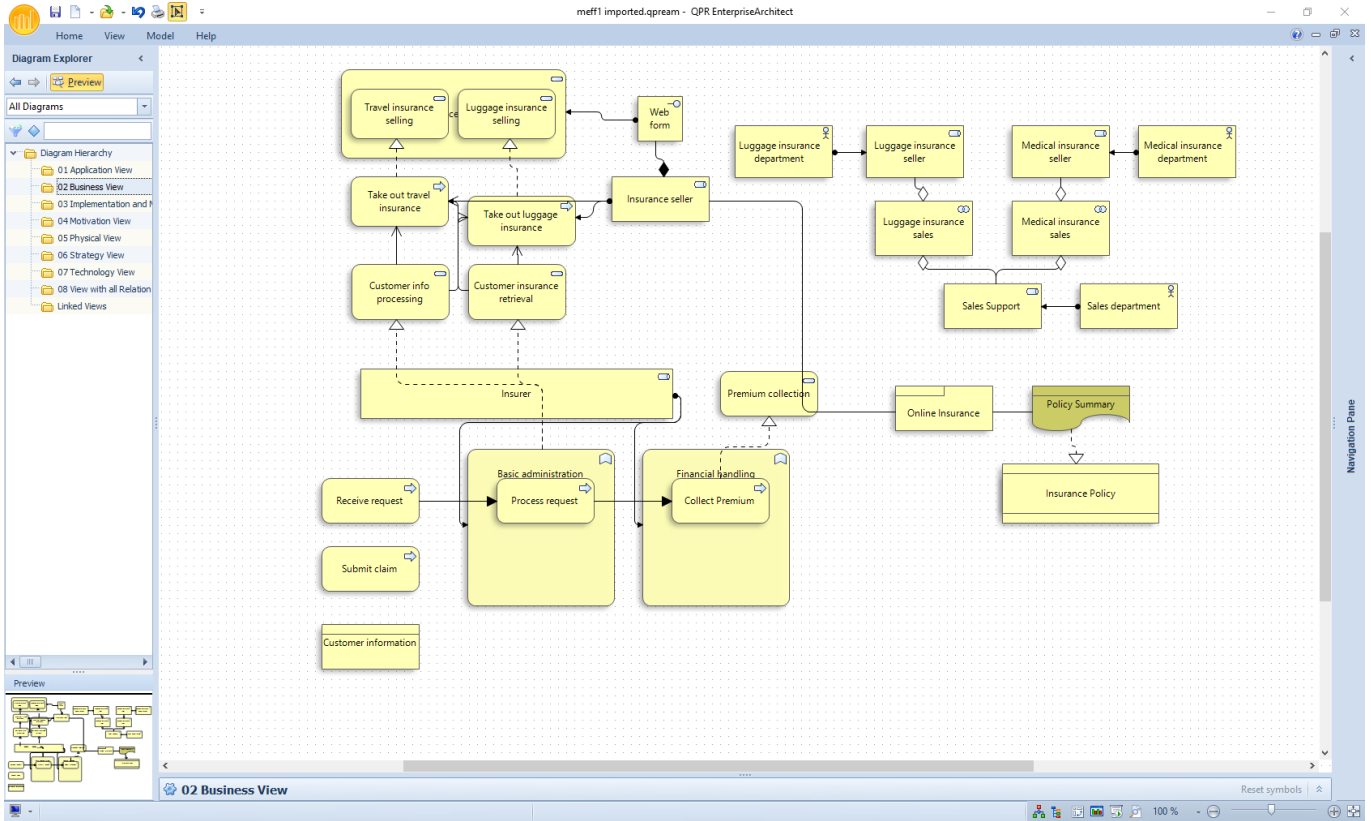
Previous step: imported meff1.xml (exported from Archi).

Next step: model contents exported to meff2.xml and imported to Sparx Systems Enterprise Architect.



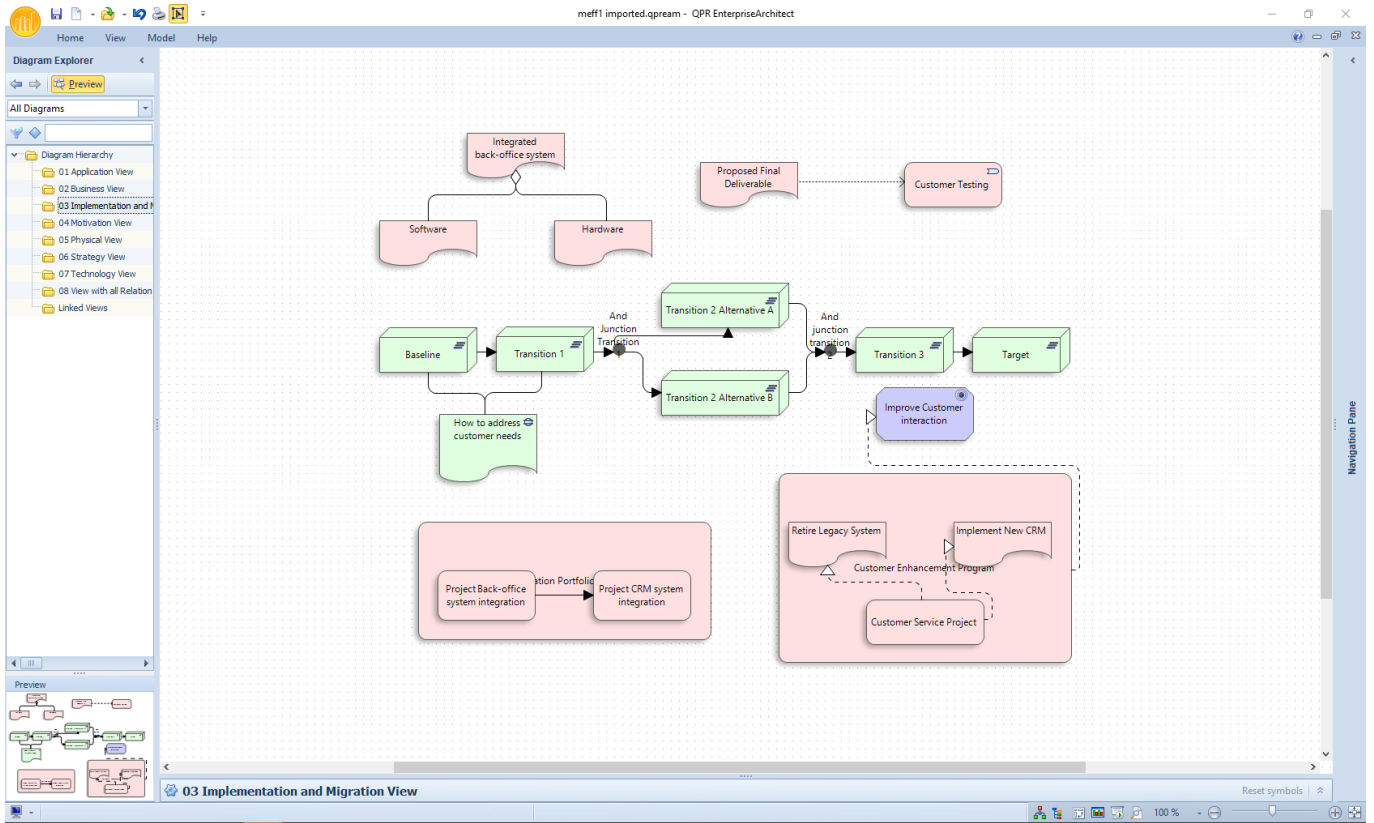
01 Application View

The vertical alignment of text in elements differs from Archi. The target model template's default alignment is middle. The Modeling Exchange File Format (MEFF) doesn't allow specification of text alignment. Also, default style of connectors in the target model is rounded elbow. In the source model it was straight. The MEFF doesn't specify connector style.



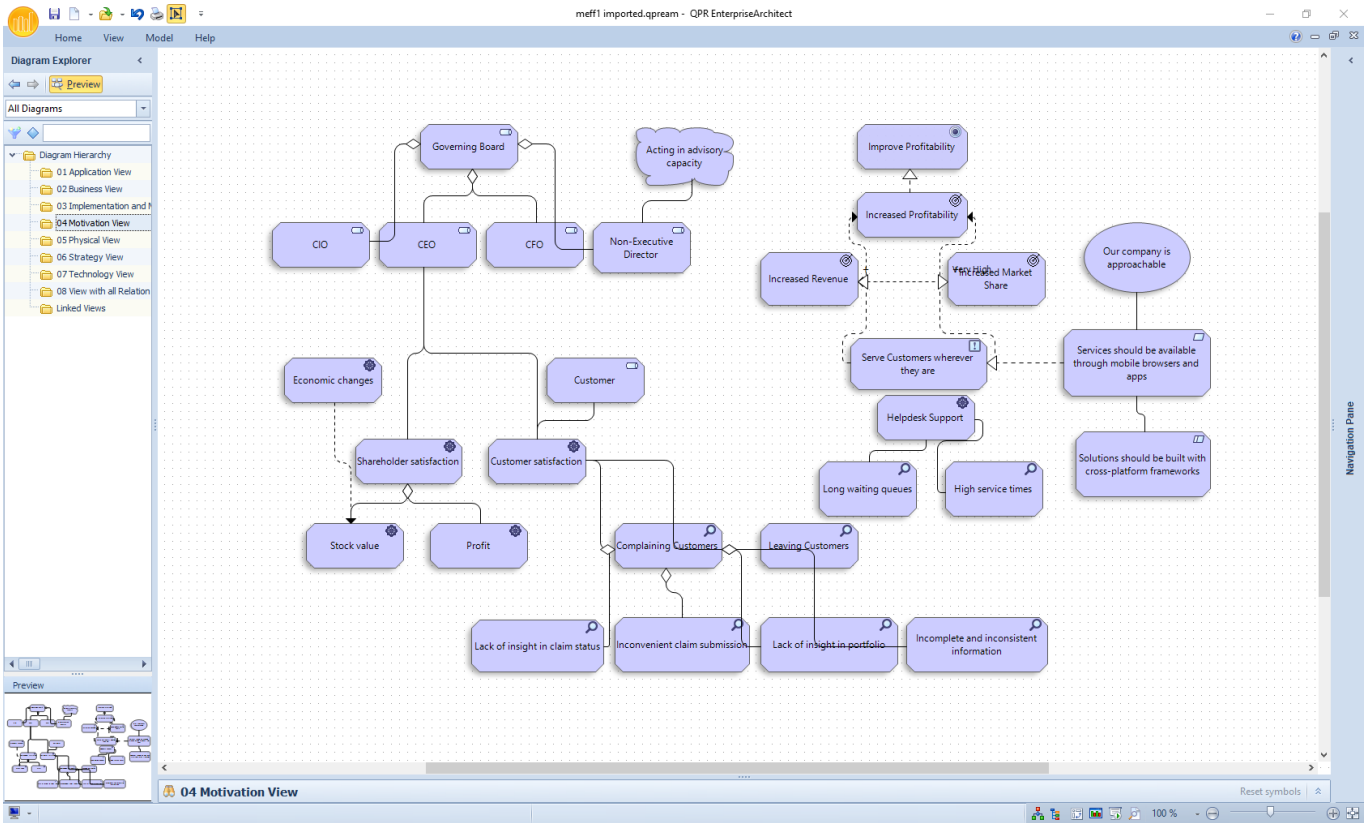
02 Business View

The alternative notation of Business interface Web form is not preserved, since there's no way of expressing alternative notation in the MEFF.

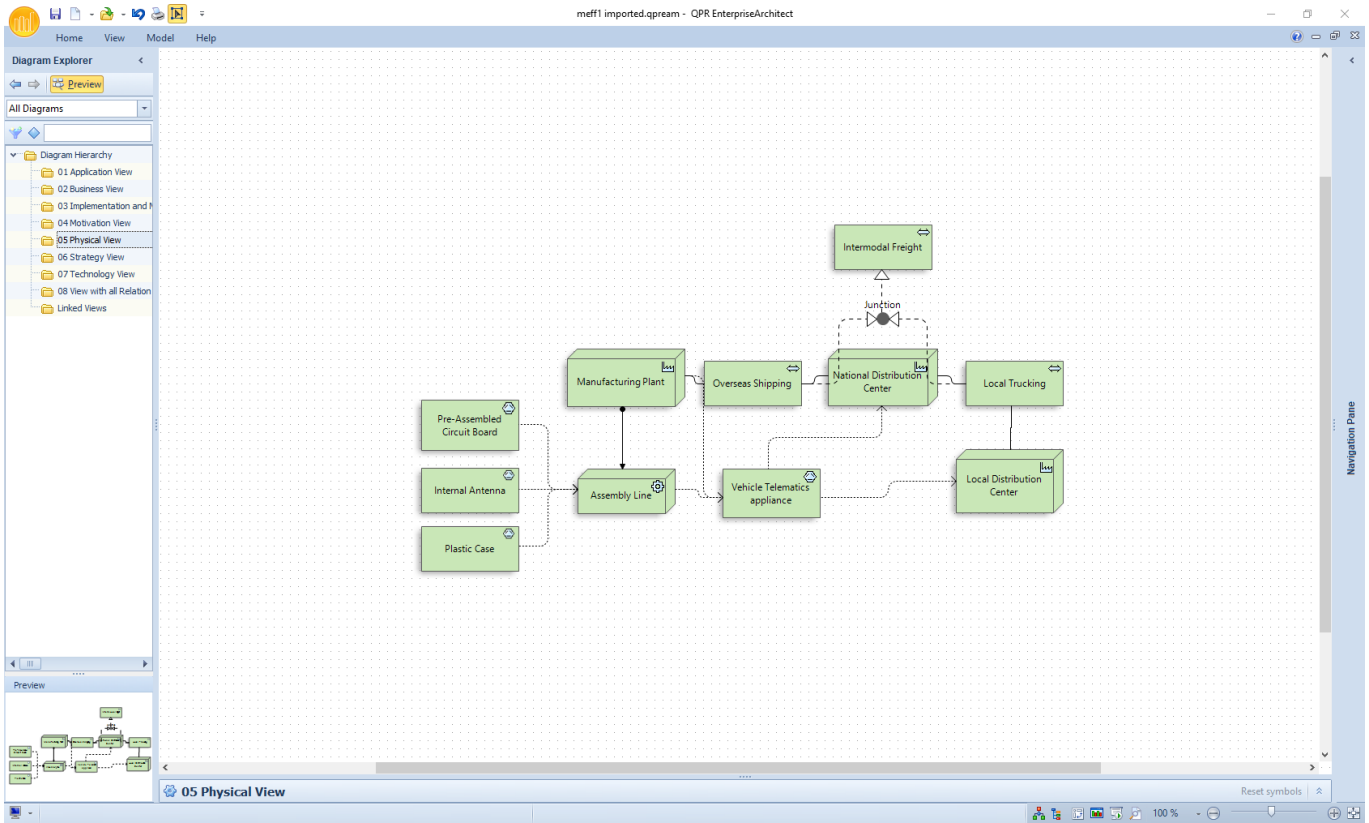


03 Implementation and Migration View

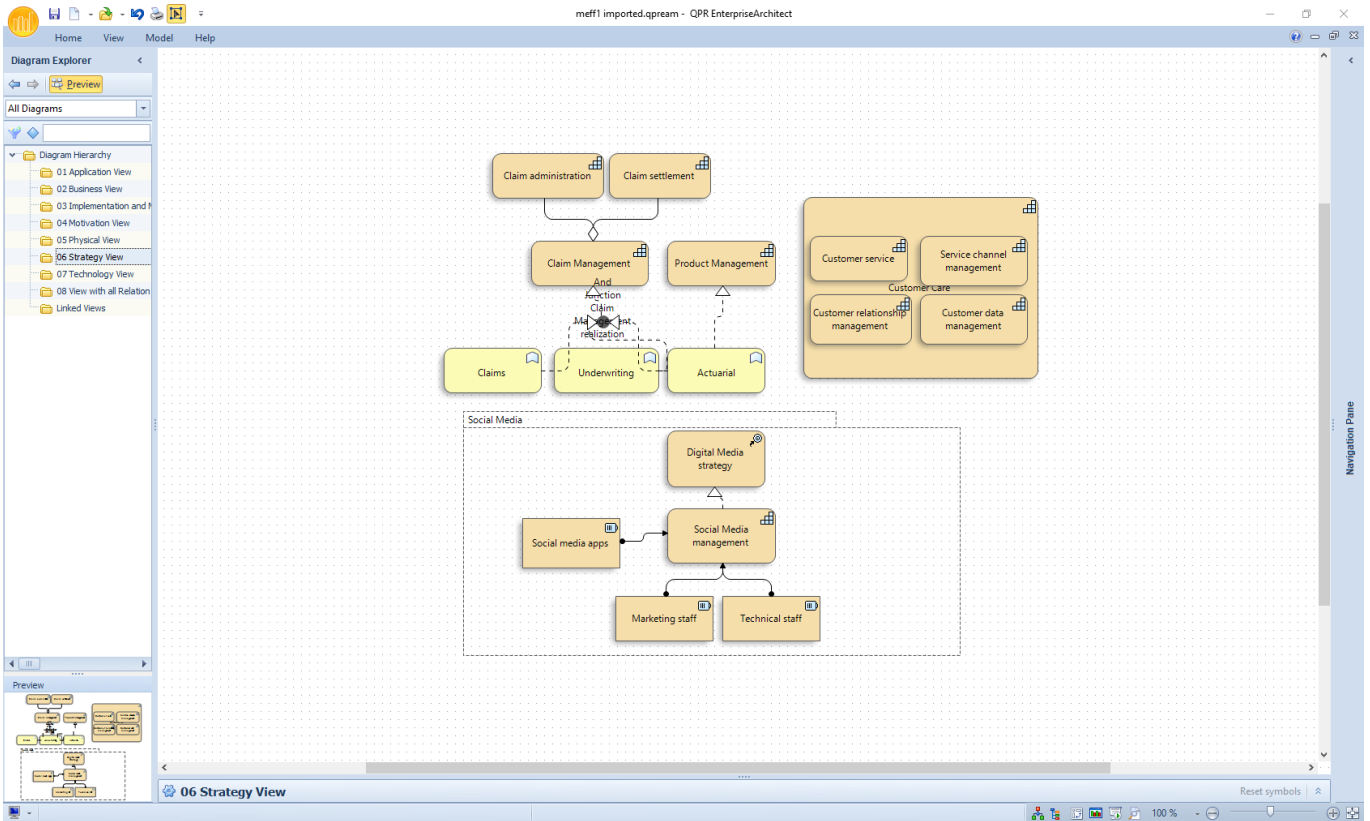
Junction names are visible in the target model although they were hidden in the source model. The MEFF file has no indication of name visibility.



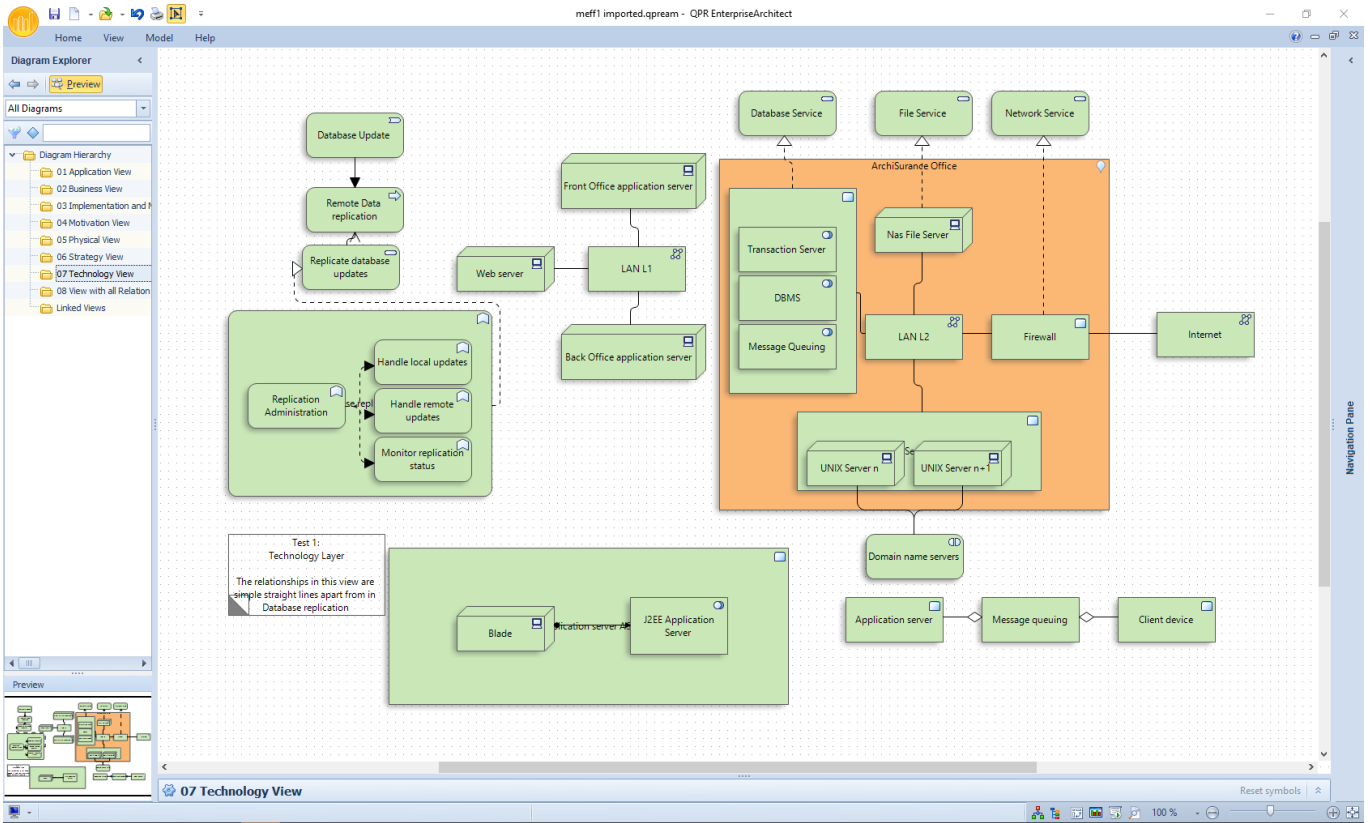

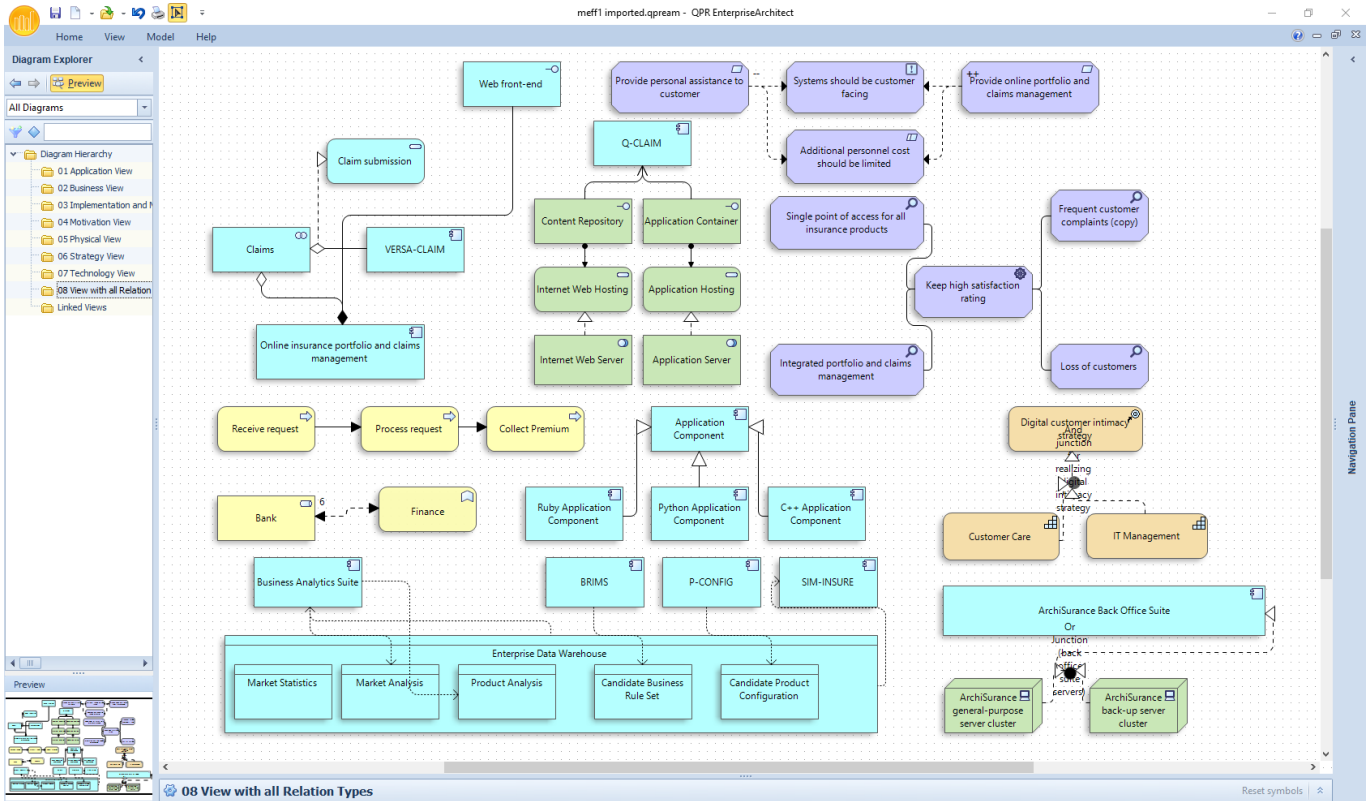

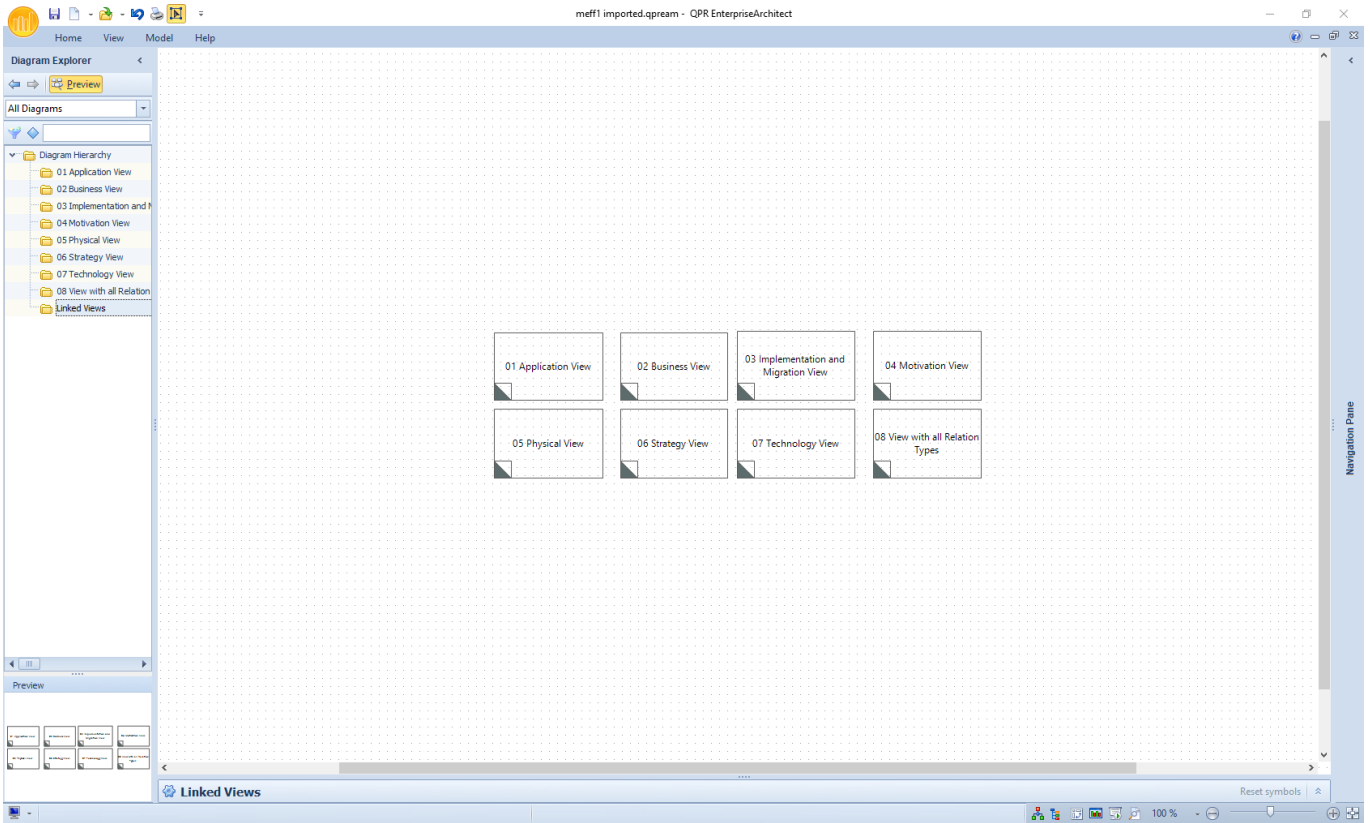
